

SSV TRAVEL GRANTS FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS & POSTDOCS

Applicants must be registered graduate students or junior post docs (<5 years). These are primarily for active international conference participation (excluding the Smögen meeting) with oral presentations of research in the field of virology. Members of SSV have priority for travel grants. Membership is acquired through participation in the annual Smögen Summer Symposium on Virology and is valid for three consecutive years following meeting participation. Applications for travel grants from SSV are accepted during the spring term, with **deadline March 1**, and during the autumn term, with **deadline October 1**. Decisions on travel grants are then taken by the board. Each award amounts to a maximum of 10.000 SEK.
